

**WAKESHMA TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

April 4, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gatlin at 7pm. Members present were Supervisor Gatlin, Treasurer Munn and Trustee Thole. Clerk Fritz and Trustee Bennett were absent. Members of the Kalamazoo County Road Commission as well as 5 citizens were in attendance.

Treasurer Munn made a motion to approve the monthly bills, Trustee Thole supported. Voice vote; passed. Trustee Thole made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Supervisor Gatlin supported. Voice vote; passed.

CITIZENS' COMMENTS: Judi Struble voiced concerns again that V Ave will flood because of the blocked culvert near her home.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: Treasurer Munn made a motion to accept the budget amendments brought forth by Supervisor Gatlin. Trustee Thole supported. Voice vote; passed. Leonidas Township notified Supervisor Gatlin that Beard Cemetery is in need of a new driveway as visitors are getting stuck. More information is needed before a vote can be taken to split the cost of the improvements. The road commission made their presentation to the township. Wakeshma has \$75,000 in par funds this year. The township received two awards, the Road Warrior Award and the Crown Award for most improved roads in the county. The road commission submitted 4 applications for local road grants and will receive grant money for 20 miles of roads.
