Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gatlin at 7:00 pm.

Motion to approve the Consent Agenda was made by Clerk Fritz, supported by Trustee Bennett.

Motion to approve Treasurer's Report was made by Clerk Fritz, supported by Trustee Thole. Approved
